

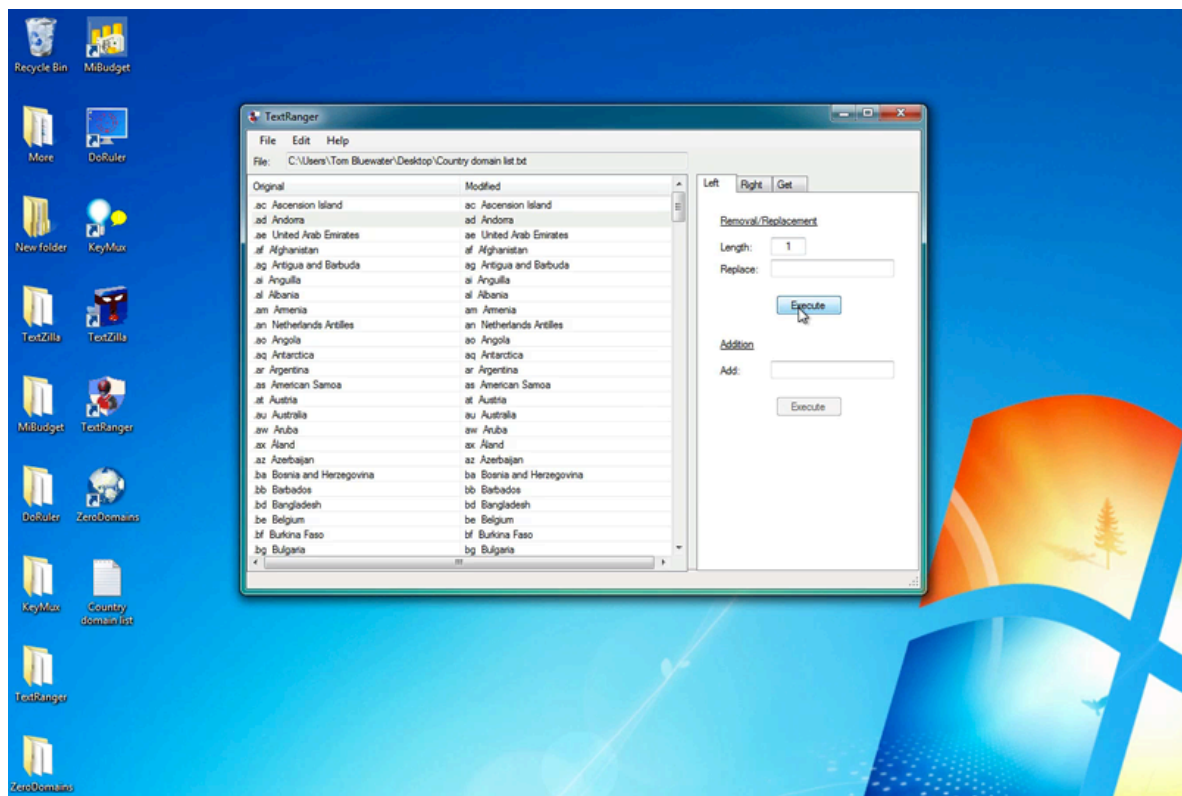

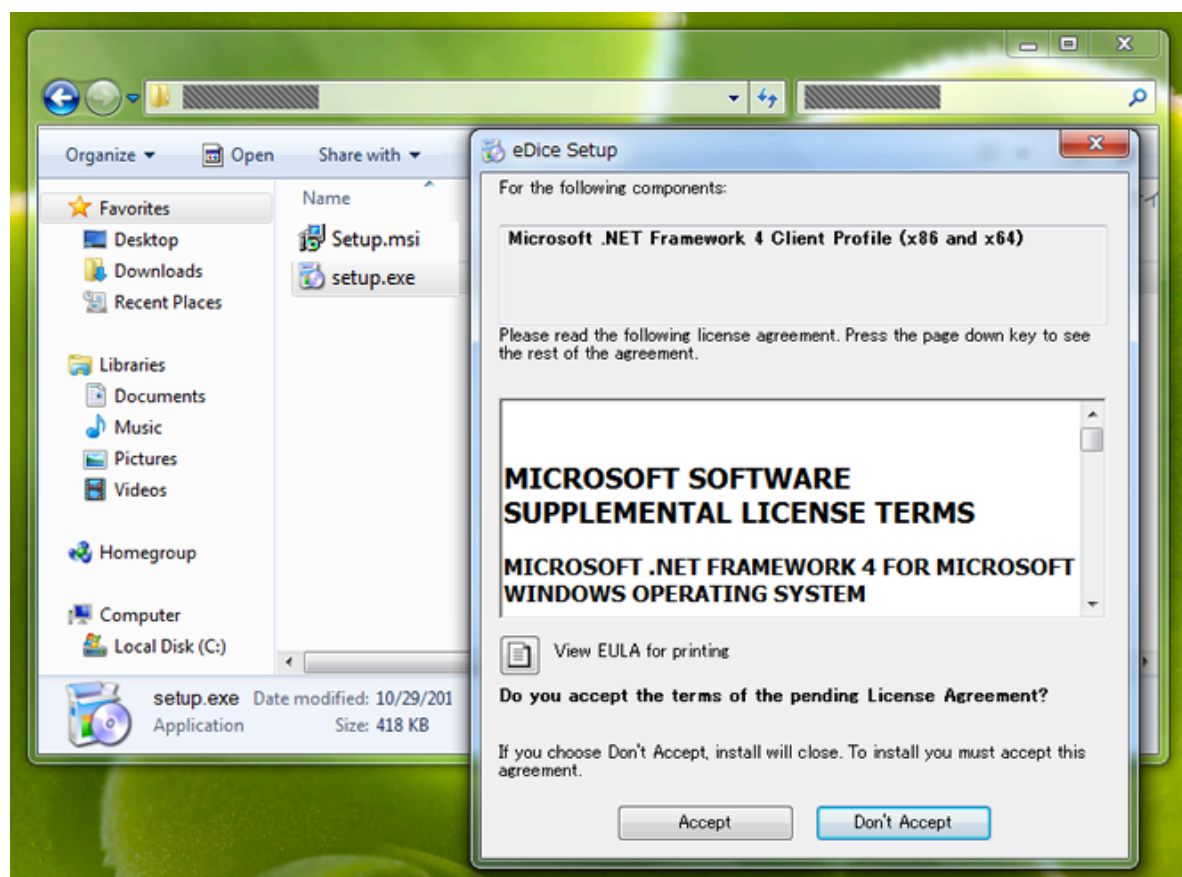

1. Introduction

TextRanger offers a non-destructive manner of editing formatted text. It is especially designed to help software developers who edit text data by just removing letters in a certain way from each line.



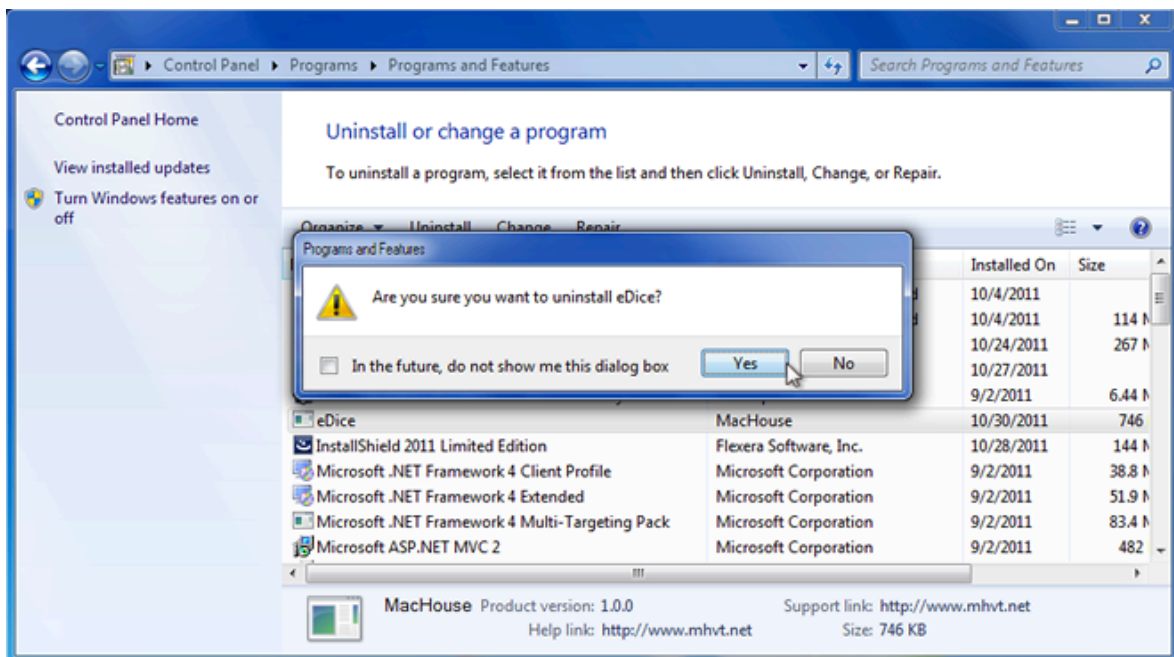

2. Installing TextRanger

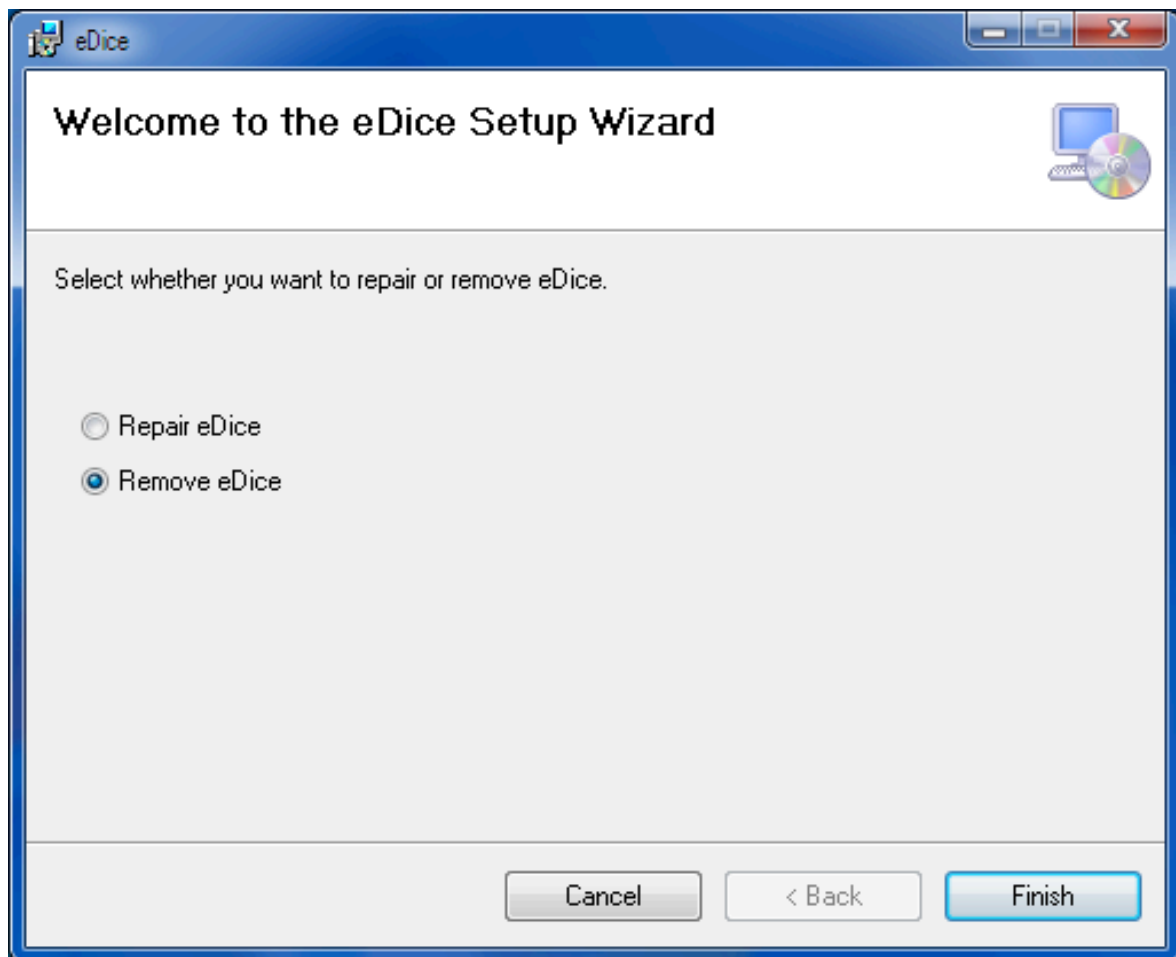
Double-click on **setup.exe** in the delivery package initiate the installation process. If your computer doesn't have it yet, TextRanger will first attempt to install **.NET Framework 4**, and you will be prompted for confirmation. (See Screenshot 2.) Then you will proceed to install TextRanger. You can use **Setup.msi** to install the application as long as you already have .NET Framework 4, which TextRanger requires. You can find the application at the following path: C:\Program Files\MacHouse\TextRanger.

3. Uninstalling TextRanger

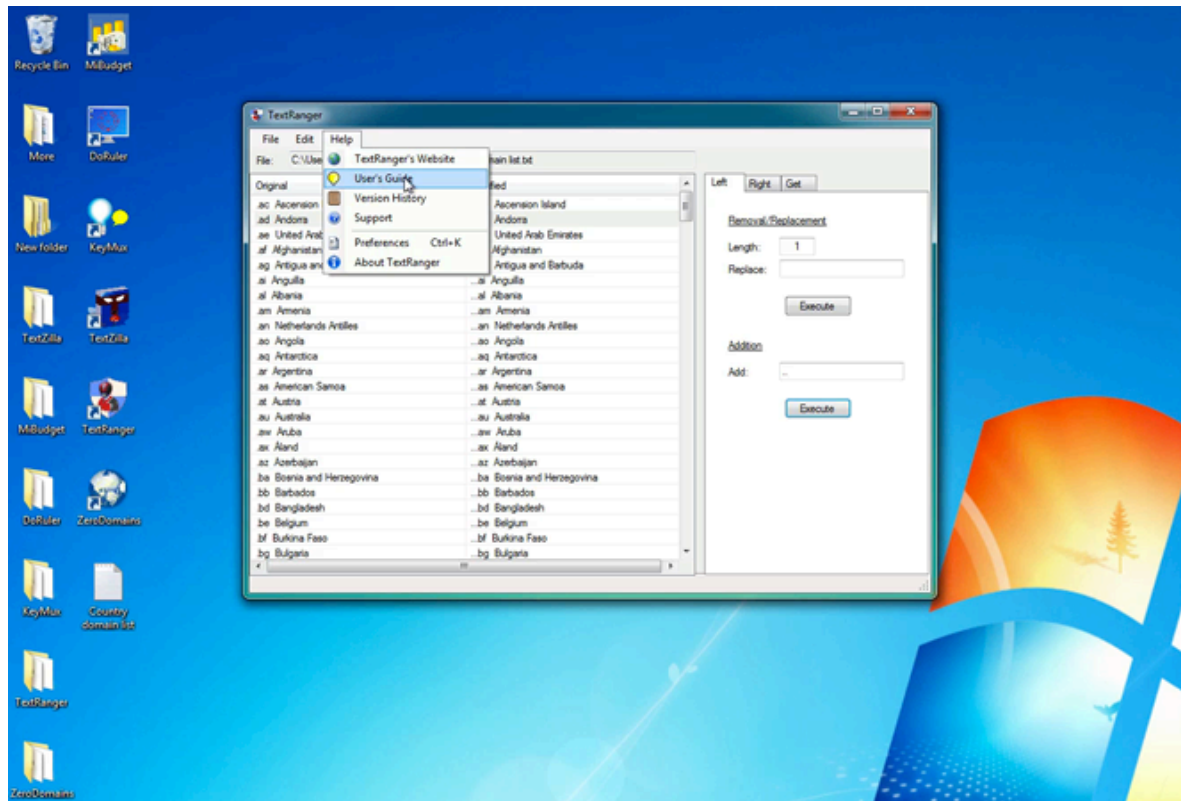
Open Control Panel and choose Uninstall a program. Then double-click on TextRanger to initiate the uninstalling process. (See Screenshot 3.) You can also use the original setup.exe or setup.msi to uninstall the application. (See Screenshot 4.) Additionally, when it starts up for the first time, the application will create a folder, which you need to manually trash. You can locate it easily by opening Preferences and navigate to the System tab.
